

CONFIDENTIALITY POLICY

REGARDING PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA ON THE WEBSITE WWW.UTA-ROMANIA.RO

This Confidentiality Policy explains the manner in which we, UTA, process your personal data on the website www.uta-romania.ro (hereinafter referred to as the “Website”).

UTA means UNION TANK Eckstein GmbH & Co. KG, a company incorporated and operating pursuant to the laws of Germany, with the registered office in Germany, Kleinostheim, registered with the Trade Register of Aschaffenburg under no. HRA 835, hereinafter referred to as “UTA”.

We are aware of the importance of your personal data, and undertake to protect its confidentiality and security. For this reason, it is important for us to keep you informed of the processing of your personal data, as user of our Website, under this confidentiality policy.

Your personal data can be supplied by you in the different sections of the Website, in particular in the following instances: when you subscribe to the UTA newsletter, when you fill in the Website’s contact form, the application form for a customized offer, the customer/trade referral form, or the form in the “Careers” section. The data supplied by you need to be true, accurate and updated, and you must have the right to provide it. Thus, you are responsible for the data you provide on the Website, both towards us, as well as towards any third party who can be injured by such provision of data.

Similarly, the Website can also collect certain information about your browsing and interactions with the different sections thereof. We shall store or access information and cookie files on your terminal equipment (computer, phone, tablet, etc.) only subject to the conditions described in the relevant section below.

If you do not agree with this Confidentiality Policy or the Terms and Conditions of the Website, you can give up accessing or using the Website.

The purposes for which we process your personal data

On the Website, we collect and process your personal data which is strictly necessary for attainment of the following purposes:

- subscription to the UTA newsletter we send away to provide news of the underlying legislation of the UTA’s solutions and services, launches of new UTA products or services, commercial information about promotions and campaigns run by UTA alone or in partnership with one or more partners, useful information about operation of the UTA’s solutions, etc.;

The information we collect to attain these purposes and which is essential for us to meet your demands and offer you access to the various functions of the Website is marked with an asterisk in the forms whereby this is collected.

You are under no obligation to fill in the fields marked with an asterisk, but if you don’t do this, we won’t be able to offer you access to the respective features.

Considering that we process your personal data on the Website on the basis of your consent, you have the right to withdraw such consent at any time by sending us a request in this respect using the contact form of the Website or using the email address or the mail address indicated in the recitals of this Confidentiality Policy, without this affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on consent

before withdrawal thereof.

How do we protect your personal data, and who can we share it with?

UTA has put in place the technical and organizational measures required under the law and the industry standards to protect your personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction, modification, loss, unauthorized disclosure or access, as well as against any other form of unlawful processing. Similarly, we take actions to make sure that we use your personal data exactly how it is described in this Confidentiality Policy, as well as to respect your choices as to processing of your personal data.

Except for the instances listed below, we shall not disclose without authorization any information concerning your data. On the basis of your express and affirmative consent granted as such and only within the limits permitted under the legislation in effect or for the purpose of fulfilling a legal obligation and/or of protecting a legitimate interest, we can share your personal data with:

- Providers of services in the following areas: marketing, administrative and transaction processing services; other providers of services; all agreeing to keep confidential such information;
- Organizations and companies which run specific surveys, and agree to keep confidential the information received;
- State and governmental agencies, when the law stipulates it;
- Other authorities and bodies, for the purpose of fulfilling our legislative obligations and/or of protecting our legitimate interests;
- Other companies we can develop joint market offers with for our products and services;

Sharing of your personal data with the aforementioned recipients shall be exclusively based on a non-disclosure agreement and ensuring adequate security thereof, so as to guarantee that the personal data is kept safe, and its transmission is in compliance with the legislation in effect.

On our Website we shall neither collect, nor disclose data about the racial or ethnic origin, political, religious, philosophical or similar beliefs, trade union membership or personal data about health or sex life.

How do we keep your personal data?

We shall keep your personal data for not longer than necessary to attain the purposes of data processing, unless there are legal provisions providing or compelling us to do otherwise.

Thus:

- regarding the UTA newsletter, we shall keep your email address in the newsletter database for as long as your subscription remains active; the moment we receive your unsubscribe request, we shall terminate any sending of newsletters to your email address;
- regarding the contact form and the application form for a customized offer, we shall keep your personal data for as long as it is necessary to answer your messages and inquiries and provide evidence of the correspondence with you;
- regarding the referral programmes, we shall keep your personal data during the period when this is required to carry out such programmes and provide evidence of your participation to such programmes;
- regarding the job applications received via the form in “Careers” section, when we decide not to act upon such applications, your data shall remain the database of UTA to be included in future recruitment processes, however for not longer than 3 years of the date of its collection;
- regarding the analytics produced for your browsing of the Website and the interactions with the Website’s users, we shall keep the data about your interactions with the Website for a period of up to 3 years.

UTA can erase your personal data when it considers this is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

Storage of information and access to the information stored on the terminal equipment. Cookies.

We neither store information, nor do we access the information stored on your terminal (computer, phone, tablet, etc.), unless with your prior agreement, or when these operations are done exclusively to make a transmission in an electronic communications networks or are strictly necessary to provide an information society service expressly requested by you (for instance, to store information about your activity on the Website so that your next use of the Website is smoother).

For any use of cookie files in respect of which your prior agreement is necessary, the Website shall ask for your agreement in a banner displayed on the Website at the time when the Website is accessed. This banner shall contain a link to this Confidentiality Policy and gives you the possibility to either accept or refuse cookie files. If you initially agreed, but then you change your mind, you can use the settings of your Internet browser to erase the information stored, or refuse further cookie files.

What are your rights regarding your personal data?

Pursuant to the legal provisions concerning protection of personal data, you benefit of a number of rights as regards your personal data:

- right of access;
- right to rectification or erasure;
- right to object;
- right not to be subject to an individual automated decision;
- right to restriction of processing and to data portability (effective 25 May 2018).

You may exercise these rights by means of a written, dated and signed request sent to the email or mail address indicated in the Recitals of this Confidentiality Policy. Last, but not least, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the National Supervision Authority for Personal Data Processing (www.dataprotection.ro), as well to take legal actions.

UTA reserves the right to amend this Confidentiality Policy. In case of amendments, the new version of the Confidentiality Policy shall be effective as of the date of its posting on the Website.
